The Ram (vv. 3-4, 20)

Daniel 8:20 - As for the ram that you saw with the two horns, these are the kings of Media and Persia.

Interpretation - Medo-Persian Empire (500s BC)

The Goat (vv. 5-8, 21-22)

Daniel 8:21-22 - And the goat is the king of Greece. And the great horn between his eyes is the first king. As for the horn that was broken, in place of which four others arose, four kingdoms shall arise from his nation, but not with his power.

Interpretation – Alexander the Great from Greece (300s BC); Four Kingdoms are Seleucus, Ptolemy, Lysimachus, and Cassander.

Daniel 8:23-24 - a king of bold face... he shall cause fearful destruction and shall succeed in what he does, and destroy mighty men and the people who are the saints.
