Matthew 1:3 - and Judah the father of Perez and Zerah by Tamar...

Genesis 38 – 1 It happened at that time that Judah went down from his brothers... There Judah saw the daughter of a certain Canaanite whose name was Shua. He took her and went in to her, 3 and she conceived and bore a son, and he called his name Er. 4 She conceived again and bore a son, and she called his name Onan. 5 Yet again she bore a son, and she called his name Shelah... 6 And Judah took a wife for Er his firstborn, and her name was Tamar. 7 But Er, Judah's firstborn, was wicked in the sight of the Lord, and the Lord put him to death...10 And what he [Onan] did was wicked in the sight of the Lord, and he put him to death also. 11 Then Judah said to Tamar his daughterin-law, "Remain a widow in your father's house, till Shelah my son grows up"—for he feared that he would die, like his brothers.
