Matthew 7:1 - Judge not, that you be not judged.

Jesus tells us not to \_\_\_\_\_ others in a foolish, prideful, or hypocritical way.

2. \_\_\_\_\_ (vv. 3-4)

**Matthew 7:3-4** - 3 Why do you see the speck that is in your brother's eye, but do not notice the log [plank] that is in your own eye? 4 Or how can you say to your brother, 'Let me take the speck out of your eye,' when there is the log in your own eye?

**Log (plank)** - a piece of heavy timber such as a beam used in roof construction

3. \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 5)

**Matthew 7:5** - You hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your brother's eye.
